



Agreement of creative cooperation

The Kazakh National University of Arts (Astana, Republic of Kazakhstan) is represented by Rector of University **AIMAN MUSSAKHAJAYEVA** acting on the base of charter and the CONSERVATORIO di ADRIA (RO) "Antonio Buzzolla" (Adria, Italy) is represented by Director of Conservatory **ROBERTO GOTTIPAVERO** acting on the base of charter, calling further as the Sides, which are looking to promote humanities, cultural and information links between creative institutes, conclude the following in given agreement.

The Subject of Agreement

The subject of this agreement is the development of partnership between the Sides in the sphere of culture, science, education and research activities.

The Sides accept the following:

Item 1

The Sides will contribute to the development of connections between institutes in the sphere of culture, science, education, research and expand contacts as for public organizations including youth associations and creative unions.

Item 2

The Sides will contribute to the raising level of theoretical quality and practice of professional education by means of international cooperation. On a mutual basis, The Sides will stimulate the interest of exchange of lecturers, professors, tutors of workshops and also realization of reciprocal consultations on the certain themes.

Item 3

The Sides are aimed to develop the new ways in training, to exchange new progresses, attainments in the informational fields and to organize participation in trainings/seminars in methodic and new approaches in the Arts.

Item 4

The Sides will encourage the exchange of coordinated number of students, masters, doctoral candidates and research scholars for education, training and probation on special disciplines at the institutes of Sides.

Item 5

The Sides will encourage, on a mutual basis, the realization of historical and cultural courses of both nations in universities of both countries. Toward this purpose, respective specialists will be invited for lecturing, seminar lessons and realization of other activities. The conditions of inviting the specialists will be extra defined in every certain case by the interested Sides.



Item 6

The Sides will regularly inform each other about the international cultural, scientific and educational conferences and seminars taking place in their countries, which are of considerable interest of both countries and encourage the participation of representatives from the other Side.

Item 7

The Sides will facilitate realization of the thematic symposiums and round table discussion, workshops, educational and methodic seminars, conferences, symposiums.

Item 8

Organization of going through a period of training of doctorates and magistrates of University.

Item 9

The sides are agreed to plan and act according to the Erasmus + Programme, shall any mutual interest occur.

Financial conditions

Financial and other conditions, also the terms of realization of arrangements will be agreed due to mutual consultations between the interested Sides with the following conclusion of separate agreement, in which all financial and legal rights and duties are fixed and under evaluation of financial possibilities for both sides.

Order of the disagreement

The Agreement will be valid for 3 years without communication and will come into effect from the date of the signature below. The Sides should inform each other in written form about dissolution, ending of the terms in advance, six months earlier. ()

Arbitration

All the controversies and difficulties of the Sides, which could appear during the execution of the present Agreement, should be solved only by negotiations.

Final conditions

The Agreement consists of two copies and each in Kazakh, English and Russian languages and all the texts have the same strength.
